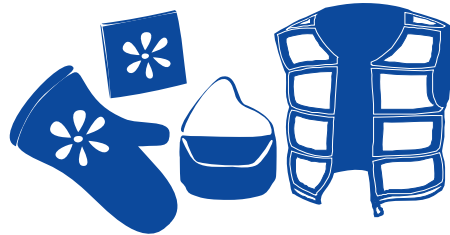


Fusible Fleece

Easy, iron-on application. 100% polyester fleece. No basting, pinning or sewing!
Use to enhance everyday sewing and wearable art fashions.



Adds a layer of softness to craft projects and apparel.

Use to add richness & depth to home decor.

Gives bags & totes a professional shape and appearance.

Fuse to fabric, cardboard or wood. The fusibility keeps the fleece from sliding around before you can get the project finished!

General Directions

1. Pre-test fleece on scrap fabric before ironing it to your project.
2. Cut Fusible Fleece to the desired size.
3. Iron in place using a wool/steam setting.

For a light bond: On ironing board, place the fleece with fusible (rough) side UP. Place the fabric right side UP on top of fleece.

For an extra strong bond: Cover fleece and fabric with a damp press cloth and press for 10-15 seconds. Repeat—overlapping with iron until entire area is fused.

Project Tips

- For additional lift, use more than one layer of fleece.
- To eliminate tedious pinning and basting, apply Fusible Fleece to the back of the fabric, then machine quilt.
- For soft toys, use Fusible Fleece to smooth out the rough edges. Fuse to the inside of the toy sections before assembling. Trim the same allowances to 1/8" (3MM) before turning and stuffing.
- To create padded appliqués, apply Fusible Fleece to the back of the shape, then machine zigzag in place.
- For wood or cardboard, fuse fleece directly to the surface, then cover with fabric.
- On foam or fiber-filled items, fuse fleece to the inside cover before assembling and stuffing.

Fabric Care Instructions

Machine wash warm. Tumble dry low. Use warm iron.

Special Uses

- Crafts: Costumes, puppets, Christmas stockings, holiday decorations, closet accessories, appliance covers, diaper bags, changing pads, hot pads, tea cozies, picnic baskets, pet beds, etc.
- Apparel: Padded appliqués, knee and elbow patch reinforcements, shoe inserts, shoulder pads, bibs, oven mitts, etc.
- Home Decorating: Wall hangings, valances, headboards, decorative boxes and picture frames, pillows, crib bumpers, etc.
